LANGUAGE AND LAUNDRY





Another everyday routine we can include children in is our laundry routine. From learning about different clothes, sorting colors, matching socks or sequencing the steps of our laundry routine--the possibilities are endless!

Take about the routine! Using our sequencing words we can walk through the steps of washing or clothes or folding our laundry!

Matching clothes! You can match clothes by item (socks and socks) or by person (mama's socks versus baby's socks). Bring in some play sounds like "Aha!" when you find a pair or exaggerating "oh no!" when we find the wrong pair.

Bring in the actions! You can work on following directions and imitating actions by throwing clothes in the basket or jumping in a pile of nice warm laundry!

Talk about what each clothing item is for! We can work on item function and body parts by describing what each item is used for. "Socks go on our feet", "Jackets keep us warm"!



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
